Job Description: Apical is hiring for the fall/winter season (September to December) with the possibility of extension into the winter/spring and spring/summer seasons. Apical research workers work a 10-on, 4-off schedule. Work location varies each shift based on project location. Essential skills that will benefit your productivity will be: ATV and sled experience, experience working outdoors in the winter, map and photo interpretation, ability to identify forest plants and trees, ability to take and record plot measurements, and operation of GPS units. On-the-job training will be available to ensure competence before any job is started. Good physical condition is necessary as considerable walking will be required. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills will be an important part of the successful applicants' attributes. Compliance with our safety program and Covid-19 expectations is mandatory.

Conditions: The successful applicant will have all of their own basic forestry equipment such as vest, boots, compass, measuring tape and weather appropriate clothing/gear. We work 10-hour days outdoors on rain and snow days and applicants must be prepared. Apical does provide fully furnished rental accommodations in crew houses when working in Grande Prairie and on days off. While at crew houses, people are expected to do their own cleaning. When working away from Grande Prairie room and board, and daily transportation to and from the job site will be provided by Apical. No pets are allowed on the job site or at crew houses/hotels.

Requirements: Basic training in forestry measurements, experience driving on resource roads (ATV and sled experience is considered an asset). Enrolled in or graduated from a 2-year Forestry or Renewable Resources technologist diploma OR enrolled in an undergraduate Degree in Forestry, Environmental Science, or a related degree.
